Engadine West students had an exciting time leading video conferences. We have a team of students who have been preparing environmental education sessions for students across NSW on Wednesday 21 November, as part of the "Green Speak Festival". Our students will be educating others in low waste, gardening, solar energy and worm farming. Students will also participate as audience members in video conferences being led by another school. Last Thursday a group of Year 5 students participated in a student leadership induction program SLIPS video conference. They enjoyed a session of evaluation, goal setting and planning with students from Heathcote East. Later this month students are booked to participate in a video conference with St George Illawarra Dragons who are inspiring students' appreciation for reading quality text.

Work has commenced on a wonderful mural being painted by our Aboriginal students, Miss Sideris and Deanna Schreiber from the Kurranulla Aboriginal Cooperation. It will feature local perspectives and be a real school asset upon completion. Also, on Monday 3 December our students will all enjoy a presentation about Aboriginal culture by Liz Cameron who lectures at Macquarie University, a performance by Aboriginal dancers and a group of students will participate in an Aboriginal art workshop.

Year 6 Excursion to Canberra

From Monday 5 to Wednesday 7 November our Year 6 students travelled to our nation's capital to participate in an action-packed civics and citizenship excursion to support their studies on Australian democracy and government. On Monday the students visited the National Parliament House where they took part in a mock parliament and toured the House of Representatives and the Senate. They also toured the Australian War Memorial and Telstra Tower. On Tuesday they went to the National Capital Exhibition Centre, Mount Ainslie Lookout, Old Parliament House, the Electoral Education Centre, the Museum of Australian Democracy, the National Film and Sound Archives and Cockington Green. On the last day they drove past many of the embassies, visited the National Museum and Questacon and participated in a guided tour of the Australian Institute of Sport.

The Parliament and Civics Education Rebate (PACER) Program provides a travel subsidy for Year 4-12 students across Australia to visit Parliament House, Old Parliament House and the Australian War Memorial and other national institutions as part of their civics and citizenship education. The PACER program is funded by the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations. This year the school received \$20 per student as a part of the PACER scheme, which went towards the cost of the excursion. We would like to thank the Australian Government for their support of this program.

We are very proud of our students who displayed excellent behaviour whilst away. We would like to thank the Year 6 teachers and Mr Fuller who took the students away. Without teachers who are willing to give up their own time for no extra pay, excursions like this could not happen.

Live Life Well

Juices for Children

Juices are not good substitutes for whole pieces of fruits or vegetables because:-

- ★ Whole pieces of fruit and veggies have higher levels of many vitamins, minerals, antioxidants and fibre.
- ★ It is easy to drink too much juice / over consume juice. One popper of juice is equal to two pieces of fruit in energy.
- ★ Too much juice can lead to diarrhea.
- ★ Whole pieces of fruits and veggies are richer in antioxidants. These nutrients can help protect against heart disease and specific cancers
- ★ Always dilute juices with half water and limit to no more than one glass a day.
