Swimming Lessons - Term 1 2013

It is proposed to have swimming lessons offered to Years 3 to 6 (2013) as an option for Friday morning sport during Term 1. These lessons will be conducted at Sutherland Leisure Centre. Children will receive a 45-minute lesson from a trained instructor plus a cap. All levels of swimming will be catered for, from non-swimmers to stroke correction. A classroom teacher will be attending the lessons with the students.

Depending on the number of children wishing to attend, the cost will vary between \$112.50 (for 42 children or more) and \$130.50 (for less than 42 children). The lessons will be conducted over 9 weeks and will begin on Friday 8 February 2013 until Friday 12 February 2013

Please note: This is an opportunity for students who are not involved in PSSA sport. We require a minimum of 25 students to participate.

No payment is needed at the moment, but full payment will be required upon receipt of a confirmation letter to be issued at the beginning of Term 1 2013.

If you are interested in allowing your child to participate in swimming during Term 1 please return the EXPRES-SION OF INTEREST form to the school by **Friday 7 December 2012**. An EXPRESSION OF INTEREST form will be sent home with Year 2 students, however, interested students in Years 3-5 will need to see Mrs Spencer to obtain a form.


