Gluten Free Facts for Healthy Kids

What is Coeliac disease?

Coeliac disease is a digestive disease that damages the small intestine and interferes with absorption of nutrients from food. **People who have coeliac disease cannot tolerate a protein called gluten, which is found in wheat, rye and barley**. Treatment of coeliac disease is by a lifelong diet free from foods containing gluten. People with coeliac disease are unable to eat any foods containing wheat, rye, barley and oats.

How do I know if a product is gluten free?

The Australian Foods Standards Code requires that any sources of gluten in a food or drink be clearly listed in the ingredients on the label:

- Food labelled as 'gluten free' must not contain any detectable gluten and no oats or malt
- Food labelled as 'low gluten' must contain less than 0.02% gluten

The gluten content must be added to the nutrition information panel of a food labelled gluten free or low gluten. Most children with coeliac disease can only eat GLUTEN FREE foods. The best way to check if a product is gluten free is to check all the ingredients. It is very important to read the labels of all packaged or prepared foods.
