Year 6 - Parliament & Civics Education Rebate

Students from our school will soon be undertaking an education tour of the national capital. Students will be given the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy.

The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion the Australian Government is contributing funding of \$20 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards those costs. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion. As this rebate will not be received by the school until very late in the term, we have already deducted the rebate from the cost of the end of year activities for Year 6 students, including the Year 6 Farewell, which means that there will be no cost for the farewell this year. We are looking forward to a fun educational experience at our national capital.

Medication at School

Students are not permitted to bring medication to school unless they are suffering from a chronic illness, eg asthma, diabetes. Only prescribed medication can be given at school.

It will be the responsibility of the child to come to the office at the correct time to receive their medication. If a student is required to take prescribed medication at school the following procedures must be adopted:

- ⇒ Parent/carer must complete a request form which can be obtained from the office or on the school website (under Notes and Forms). The medicine and administration procedures must be clearly identified.
- ⇒ Administration procedures will be recorded at the front office.
- ⇒ The medication will be kept secure in the office and administered under the supervision of the Administration Manager.
- ⇒ All medication needs to be brought to school in the original container labelled with the child's name and doctor's instructions about dosage, times and storage details.

Teachers and other staff are not permitted to administer medication.


The weather was beautiful, the entertainment was fantastic and the kids all seemed to be having a fabulous time.


