




# How to Access Audiobooks Through the Engadine West Public School Library




Open a web browser and type in <https://education.nsw.gov.au/>

Log on to the student portal using student user name and password

First time users may like to take the guided tour


Click on the Orbit icon to continue






Type 'audio' and select 'audiobooks' from dropdown menu

## TIPS

Once you have finished a book please return it so another library member can borrow it.

The mobile apps download your eBook in the background as soon as you start reading it, so you can then read the eBook when you are offline.

Audiobooks can be downloaded in the mobile apps but you need to choose this option from the menu options.

If your loan expires before you have finished the book, you can immediately reborrow the book as long as it has not been reserved by another library member.
