<p>Additional Information:</p>	<p>Founded in 2000, The Business Concierge has been presenting life skills courses in high schools, youth groups, prisons and employment service providers for almost a decade. In this time they have worked closely with the Federal Government's Finance Literacy Foundation, identifying the areas within finance education that should be addressed. They have also worked closely with the Salvation Army, facing many examples of the impact that a lack of financial education can have on individuals, families, and the community in general.</p> <p>In a world that is increasingly consumer-driven, they feel that finance literacy is one of the most important skills that an individual can acquire throughout their time in the education system. However, an already full school curriculum makes the target of 'financial literacy for all' very hard to achieve.</p> <p>The 90 minute program is designed to be presented per individual class of up to 35 students, and take place within the school hall or a large classroom. Through a range of activities, both physical and mental, they aim to improve knowledge of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - what money is, where it comes from, how it can be borrowed, and what an income is; - what the rights and responsibilities of the consumer are; - what goods and services are, and the role they play in society; - what a budget is and how it works; - how income is created through initiative; - the value of savings; - how financial decisions can affect an individual, and the people around them. <p>The cost of this incursion is usually \$12 per student, however, due to a contribution by Sutherland District Trade Union Club (Tradies), it is reduced to \$7 per student.</p>
