Description:	Five-day school water safety program run by the Department of Education NSW School Sport Office.
Cost:	\$24.00
Venue:	Engadine Leisure Centre (Anzac Avenue, Engadine)
Transport:	Students will walk to and from Engadine Leisure Centre escorted and supervised at the pool by teachers from Engadine West PS.
Dress Code:	 Apply sunscreen in the morning. Full school uniform is to be worn to school each day of the program. To reduce the issue of lost clothing and to save lesson time, students will change into their swimmers at school and wear their jumper/jacket/tracksuit or dressing gown over the top to walk to the pool. Upon return to school, students will change from their swimmers into their underwear and school uniform. They will bring wet items home each day in the same bag. Students will need to bring some light clothing to do a 'clothed swim' on day five of the program.
Food:	Fruit break, recess and lunch as usual. PLEASE NOTE: lunch orders WILL NOT be available for the entire week.

Educational Outcomes:	Water safety and survival swimming
Additional Information:	This program is available to all Year 2 students regardless of their swimming
	ability. The school water safety program develops water confidence and provides students with basic skills in water safety and survival.
	Our school has selected this shorter five-day survival swimming program as
	opposed to the ten-day learn to swim program as it provides the essential first layer in the protection and prevention against drowning. It is also a more
	manageable program for our school, due to staff shortages both at our school
	and within the NSW School Sport Office.
	Students should be encouraged to attend all five lessons to get the full benefit
	of the program. If your child is unable to attend any lessons due to illness or
	other unforeseen circumstance, please send an explanatory note to the class teacher.
	The school has been allocated two session times:
	2M and 2P will attend the first session from 1:15pm to 2:00pm.
	2H and 2W will attend the second session from 2:00pm to 2:45pm. Each lesson is for 45 minutes with our teachers in attendance for each session
	Students will be assessed during the program for all water safety skills withou
	wearing goggles.
	The School Water Safety program is free, however there is a fee of \$24 for poo
	entry. Multi season passes are no longer accepted.
