Year 6 Canberra Excursion Information - 1- 3 May 2023

Dear parents/carers

The Year 6 Canberra Civics and Citizenship excursion will take place **Monday 1 - Wednesday 3 May 2023.**Many thanks to those parents who have paid the \$200 deposit. The full cost of the excursion is \$525.00 (including the deposit) and this payment can be made now. Please contact the school office if you are unsure of the balance of your account or if you are experiencing financial difficulties. Please read the following information carefully and ensure all payments are completed **by Thursday 6 April 2023.**

Excursion information

On Monday 1 May 2023 students will need to arrive at school at 6.15am.

When students arrive, they should enter the school by the gate near the Care Centre on Ridge Road. This will be the only gate open at this time of morning. We will meet on the fake grass area next to the gate, or in the case of rain, under the K-2 COLA. Please avoid parking in the bus zone when dropping off students as the buses need to park here. Buses arrive at school for loading by 6.30am.

Upon arrival, students need to see their teacher and have their name marked on the roll. If your child has medication, it must be in its original packaging, labelled with the student's name and dosage requirements, and given to their class teacher. The Medical Information Google Form should have been completed prior to the excursion for any medication. Any emergency medications that need to be with students (eg asthma puffer, Epipen etc) should be kept in students' daypacks. Students will need to show that they have this medication. Students will then be directed to use the toilet before loading their luggage and boarding the buses.

Students should have a small day backpack and one larger luggage bag with them. In the backpack they need a packed recess, lunch and a refillable water bottle. They may also bring things they may need on the bus, such as a reading book, notepad or card games. Students are **not required to wear school uniform.** Students should wear comfortable, appropriate clothes suitable for the weather and activities - neat and tidy with no offensive slogans, no backless tops or revealing shorts.

In their luggage bag, students need to pack clothes for two more days. Make note of the expected temperature and pack accordingly. Thongs and sandals are not appropriate for the daytime excursions but may be worn around the accommodation. A hat is essential for outdoor activities and a raincoat/spray jacket should be packed too. *Please ensure all belongings are labelled*.

Linen (including towels) is provided by the accommodation. Information on what to bring (and not bring) is attached. Please note, **no mobile phones or electronic equipment** other than a camera are to be brought on the excursion. These can create problems with inappropriate use, theft or loss. If parents need to contact students or teachers, please use Seesaw or contact the school.

Students are allowed to bring money to spend, at the discretion of parents. We recommend no more than \$50. On the way home on Wednesday night we will be stopping at McDonalds for a comfort stop. Students may choose to purchase food for dinner. They may also wait until we return home. If students bring money they will need to put an amount for the comfort stop aside. Teachers will not mind money for students, nor will they pay for dinners if students over-spend beforehand.

The coaches will arrive back at the school at approximately 7.30pm on Wednesday 3 May 2023, with any change to arrival time notified via Skoolbag/Facebook/Seesaw. Please do not park in the bus bays on this night. In the interest of safety, please ensure that your child's name is marked off by their teacher on the class roll before taking them home.

A detailed itinerary for the excursion is attached to this note. While on the excursion, we will be sharing photos and updates via the school's official Facebook page and teachers may share via Seesaw if time allows.

COVID Smart Plan

We have created a COVID Smart plan alongside our risk assessment plan. We will review this in line with updated NSW Health guidelines closer to the date. At this point in time, please be aware:

- We may request that all students take a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) prior to departure on the morning of Monday 1 May 2023.
- Students with any COVID symptoms will not be allowed to board the bus.
- On the excursion, any students displaying COVID symptoms will be isolated under supervision of a teacher in a
 comfortable location and asked to take a rapid antigen test (RAT). If a student tests positive to COVID-19 they
 will continue isolation and parents/carers will be contacted. Parents will be required to drive to Canberra to
 pick up their child.
