Stage 3 Public Speaking Competition

Dear parents/carers,

Class and stage competition -Term 2

To support *argument and authority (persuasive writing)* in English this term, students will participate in public speaking. Students are asked to prepare a persuasive speech to present to their class. There will also be an impromptu aspect delivered in class. All students will deliver their speeches in class, however, they have a choice as to whether they want their speech to be considered for the grade or stage final of the school public speaking competition. Class winners and subsequent stage finalists will be notified on Seesaw.

Students will be revising persuasive texts in class this term. This learning will support the writing of their speeches. Students will need to place their speeches onto palm cards in preparation for their speech.

Topics for the prepared speech

Students should choose a topic that they feel very strongly about so that they can speak with sincerity. They should also choose a topic that is appropriate for a Stage 3 audience.

Marking

Prepared and impromptu speeches will be marked on:

Manner 20%	Method 40%	Matter 40%
How it is said: eye contact, body language, pitch, tone, volume and cards.	How the subject matter is arranged: how balanced the argument is or how well supported.	What is said: its relevance to the topic, suitability, originality, how clearly the opinion is presented.
